Reading Log Example:

date: November 4, 2002

title of the book: The Three Little Pigs

author's name: Margot Zemach

summary: The Three Little Pigs is about three pigs and a big bad wolf.

The story begins when the mommy pig sends her three little pigs out into the world to make a strong house for the family. The three little pigs get into a fight and make different houses. The first little pig builds a house of straw. The big bad wolf blows the house down because he wants to eat the pig. The second pig builds a house of sticks and the wolf blows it down.
